#### Even More amazing facts about horses

- 1. The average horse's heart weighs approximately 9 or 10 pounds.
- 2. The record for the longest jump over water is held by a horse named Something who jumped 27 feet, 6 and ¾ inches on April 25, 1975 in Johannesburg, South Africa. He was ridden by Andre Ferreira.
- 3. The record for the highest jump made by a horse is held by a horse named Huaso who jumped 8 feet, 1 and ¼ inches on February 5, 1949 in Vina del Mar, Chile. He was ridden by Captain Alberto Larraguibel.
- 4. Scientists believe that the first known ancestor of the horse lived about 50 million years ago. This prehistoric horse is called Eohippus and had four padded toes on the front legs and three padded toes on the back legs.
- 5. Horses with typical anatomy are "obligate nasal breathers" which means they must breathe through their nostrils and cannot breathe through their mouths.
- 6. Horses can drink at least 25 gallons of water a day.
- 7. It takes 9-12 months to re-grow an entire horse hoof.
- 8. Horses with pink skin can get a sunburn.
- 9. A zebroid is a cross between a zebra and any other member of the family Equidae (which, besides zebras includes donkeys, ponies and horses). A "zonky" is a cross between a zebra and a pony. A "zorse" is a cross between a zebra and a horse.
- 10. You can tell if a horse is cold by feeling behind its ears. If that area is cold, so is the horse.
- 11. Horses have 16 muscles in each ear, allowing them to rotate their ears 180 degrees.
- 12. If a horse has a red ribbon on its tail, it kicks.
- 13. Horses are social animals and will get lonely if kept alone, and they will mourn the passing of a companion.
