**Welcome** to the Phoenix Equestrian Center, home of Oxbow! It all started in Newfoundland, NJ in 1959 when Veron and Whitney Bowles founded the Oxbow Riding Club, a boarding, training and teaching riding center. The goals were the same as they are today: to teach and preserve the art of traditional horsemanship. The Oxbow Raiders 4-H Club, one of the oldest 4-H clubs in the state, was organized in 1963.

Today, we continue to focus on correct, classical riding. Our training of both horse and rider gives the rider the skill and the horse the means to go out and excel in any arena: dressage, eventing, jumpers or pleasure riding.

**STABLE MANAGEMENT:** Work in the barn learning how to clean stalls, clean tack, watering, feeding
